WebDAV file sharing for iOS devices

Having saved the documents to a WebDAV folder students can access their work from other iOS apps or from desktop operating systems such as OS X and Windows.

Mac OS X 10.7 Lion Server makes a cost effective host for shared folders via WebDAV for iOS devices and makes the setup a breeze. Many other server operating systems will also support WebDAV file sharing and we can help to advise on that.

Once you have a WebDAV facility running on your

network your iOS devices will be able to save work to network folders, and you will see familiar folder and file navigation windows. Apple's Pages app is a great example of WebDAV support, and take a look at Keynote, GoodReader, AirShare and OmniGraffle for other great examples.

The iPad is going to be very big in schools, predicts Professor Mark Warschauer, one of the world's leading experts in technology and learning.

In an exclusive interview, Prof. Warschauer predicted that schools may soon start buying iPads in big numbers to replace not just desktops and laptops, but also textbooks and other reading materials.

"Until a couple of years ago, the majority of book reading – and a lot of magazine and newspaper reading – was done in print," he said in a phone interview. "I think we're going to see that change now."

"The laptop is great, but the iPad is potentially better in a lot of ways," he said. "It's a lot better for reading. It's a lot more interactive with the touch screen. It's lighter. It's smaller. It's got a 10 hour battery life and

Previous studies have shown that in order to stay relevant in the 21st Century, schools need to stay on top of rapid changes introduced by digital media. In its short existence as a learning tool, the iPad has enabled teachers to promote collaborative, independent, and differentiated learning.

Professor Mark Warschauer, one of the world's leading experts in technology and learning

it costs a lot less than the cheapest Mac laptop."

"There will be a lot of interest," Warschauer said. "You can do a lot of the stuff you can do on laptops, but they are great for reading, especially as textbooks go into the digital realm."

He said reading is likely to go digital very fast, and that many people will soon have two computing devices: a computer

or laptop for writing, and a tablet for reading.

"For a lot of adults, they will have both a writing and a reading device," he said. "They will have a laptop or a desktop, and an iPad or a Kindle or something."

But schools can't afford to give kids two machines. They will likely opt for the cheapest machine that can do double duty: the iPad.

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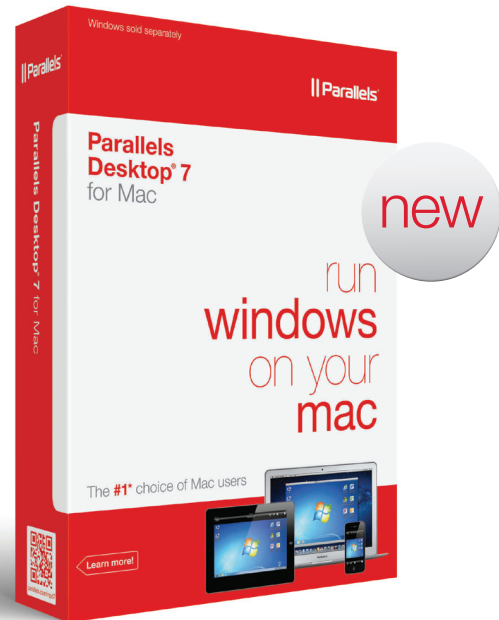
